Calling adults with an acquired facial difference

My name is Anne-Marie. I'm a researcher doing a PhD (at Liverpool University) and I'd like to interview you about your experiences of living with an acquired facial difference, as well as your life before and after.

I make no assumptions. I'm interested in hearing your story told in your words.

The information will be used to provide more insight into the lives of facially different adults, to increase knowledge and to reduce ignorance.

I'm looking to interview 18 adults in reasonable health who have had an acquired facial difference for at least 2 years. If you are willing to take part and fit the research profile we will conduct the interview at a time and location of your choosing. It will last approximately 1 to 2 ½ hours. There will be comfort breaks and you are welcome to have someone with you if you wish.

I would like to invite you to bring one of your possessions with you to the interview, anything that helps you to tell your story.

So I can listen and maintain accuracy I would like to record your story with a small digital recorder, but this is optional. All findings will be anonymised and kept confidentially. You also have the right to opt out without explanation at any point.
